FRED CHAMBERLIN

Fred Chamberlin, aged 94, a retired farmer, died October 31, 1955, at the home of his son, Fred, 16 Water St., Binghamton.

He was born June 1, 1861, in the Town of Richfield, son of Charles and Charlotte Derthick Chamberlin. He attended district schools.

He married Ella Rathbun of Springfield Center April 1, 1893 in Richfield Springs. They lived in this village for a time and later on the W. B. Ward farm, East Lake Rd. Later they moved to a farm at Allen's Lake where they lived for six years. From there they moved to a farm near Troy, where they lived three years before moving to Schuyler Lake. In 1943 they moved to Binghamton where they resided since. Mrs. Chamberlin died in 1948.

He attended the Universalist Church.

He leaves three sons, Fred, James of Greene and Roger of Smyrna, Ga.; a grandchild and two great grandchildren, several nieces and nephews.

The funeral was held Thursday from the McGrath Funeral Home, the Rev. C. Frederick Fraser, pastor of the First Presbyterian Church, officiating. Burial was in Springfield Center Cemetery.
