FREDERICK H. CHAPIN

Frederick H. Chapin died suddenly of heart disease on Thursday afternoon at 47 Irving Place, the home of Alexander C. Rogers, with whom he had lived for fifteen years.

Mr. Chapin was fifty-five years old, and was the son of the late [Hannah Newland Chapin and] Dr. E. [Edwin] H. Chapin, who was pastor of the Church of the Divine Paternity [Fourth Universalist Society of the City of New York]. Mr. Chapin was in the dry-goods business at 76 Leonard Street, and was also an appraiser for the Surrogate.

Mr. Chapin was born in Boston. He married Miss Helen Kirk of Troy, who died sixteen years ago. He was a prominent member of the Democratic Club and of the New-York Athlete Club. He leaves a son, Edwin Chapin of Pigeon Cove, Mass.; a daughter, Mrs. Harold Graham of Chicago, and a sister, Mrs. Charles Davison of this city. The funeral will be held to-morrow at 11 o'clock.
