After an illness of three years, Bradley J. Chapman, sr., died last Saturday morning last, aged 78 years. Mr. Chapman was born at Henrietta, Monroe county, but came to Genesee county many years ago locating on a farm in Alabama, whence he removed 27 years ago to Oakfield where he had since resided. He amassed a large fortune during his active life and for several years had not been engaged in business pursuits. He was a director of the Bank of Batavia for a long time. Mr. Chapman leaves a widow [Malinda], and one brother, Chauncey Chapman, of Henrietta. The funeral was held Monday afternoon at his late residence on Main street. The Rev. Asa Saxe, of Rochester, Universalist, officiated. The bearers were H. C. Martin, W. W. Stevens, John W. Heal, A. B. Rathbone, Henry Caple and I. J. Stedman. The interment was in the Oakfield cemetery.
