MRS. ANNE CHURCH

Canton, Aug. 5.—Mrs. Anne Church was buried yesterday at Edmeston, Ohio. Mrs. Church was the eldest daughter of Dr. and Mrs. Isaac M. Atwood, former president of [the] Universalist Theological school located at St. Lawrence university, and now pastor of the First Universalist church of this place. Mrs. Church's husband died Nov. 16, 1912. Dr. Church was president of Buchtel college, Akron, Ohio, from 1910 to the time of his death.

Mrs. Church graduated from St. Lawrence university in June, 1886, and two years later, [on] Sept. 5, 1888, she was united in marriage with the late Dr. Church. Four children survive Mrs. Church: Evelyn, aged 20, who was graduated last year from Buchtel College; John, 18, a student in Buchtel; Harold and Dorothy, who are attending High school.

Mrs. and Dr. I. M. Atwood have been at Edmeston since Thursday last. Mrs. Church leaves one brother, John M. Atwood, professor of philosophy at St. Lawrence, and three sisters, Mrs. W. Manley and Miss Nora Atwood of Canton and Miss Alice Atwood of Washington, D.C.
