Dexter, June 25—Following an illness of two days, Mrs. Abigail Clark, wife of Edward S. Clark, passed away at her home here at 5 Wednesday afternoon. She had resided here for a period covering nearly 60 years. Death was caused from worry over her husband's illness. He has been ill for several weeks. Mrs. Clark was 81 years old.

Born in Columbia, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Nicholas Vincent, she was married in 1855, and she, with her husband, came to Dexter shortly after. Mrs. Clark was a member of the Universalist church of this place. She was able to be about the house until a few days ago, and a week ago Wednesday was in Watertown.

Mrs. Clark is survived by her husband, and three sons, H. V. Clark, postmaster of the village, F. B. Clark of Dexter and Brayton R. of Malone. She also leaves one daughter, Mrs. L. F. Lehr of Watertown.

The funeral will be held from her late home Friday afternoon at 3, Rev. Harry Westbrook Reed, pastor of All Souls [Universalist] church, Watertown, officiating. Interment will be made in the Dexter cemetery.
