## ARCHIE CLEVELAND

Pillar Point—The funeral for Archie L. Cleveland, 84, who died unexpectedly Saturday morning at his home, South Shore Road, was Tuesday morning at the Cleveland-McCallen Funeral Home, Watertown, with Rev. Ivan V. Greenfield, pastor of the Dexter United Methodist church, officiating. Burial was in Brookside Cemetery, Watertown.

Mr. Cleveland is survived by his widow, Mrs. Ruth W. Brawt King Cleveland; a son by his first marriage, Adrian W., Sebago Lake, Maine, who is on his way to Europe; his brother, Howard M., Watertown; a step-son, Eward L. King, Montpelier, Vt.; two grandchildren and three step-grandchildren.

Born near Harrisville Nov. 19, 1884, Mr. Cleveland was the son of Orville M. and Sarah Shoemaker Cleveland. He was educated in Harrisville schools and was graduated from Black River High School.

Mr. Cleveland married three times. His first wife, from whom he was divorced, was Mrs. Hazel S. Herrick Cleveland, who died June 19, 1932 after an illness of 14 years. On June 25, 1935 he married Mrs. Nina Roof Timmerman, in Oswego. She died Nov. 9, 1956.

On May 28, 1958, Mr. Cleveland married Mrs. Ruth W. King, in a ceremony at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Howard M. Cleveland, 1023 Sherman St., Watertown, his brother and her sister. Rev. Dr. Harold H. Niles, retired pastor of All Souls Universalist Church officiated. They had lived on Pillar Point since their marriage.

As a young man, Mr. Cleveland worked for A. Bushnell Co., in Watertown, then for a short time for the Agricultural Insurance Co. In the 1920s he went to Binghamton, where he was employed as manager of the floor covering department of [the] Montgomery Ward store until his retirement in 1952, when he and Mrs. Nina Cleveland moved here.

Mr. Cleveland was a member of All Souls Unitarian Universalist Church, Watertown, Dexter Lodge 1072, F&AM, and the Dexter Rod and Gun Club.
