THE DEATH RECORD

Williston T. Clover died at his residence in Fort Plain yesterday afternoon, aged 49 years. He had been confined to his bed since January with sciatic rheumatism, which, with heart difficulty, caused his death. Mr. Clover was born in Annsville, this county, in 1843, but had resided at Taberg until 1890. In the fall of 1890 he moved to Fort Plain and established a livery stable which he conducted until death. He was a member of Fort Plain Lodge, No. 433, F. & A.M., and a member of the Universalist Church of that village. Besides his wife he is survived by four children, Myra M., Kittie M., Burt B. and Harvey, of Fort Plain, and one brother, Orange, of Taberg. The funeral will be held at his old home in Taberg on Monday.
