Death of Arthur M. Cock

Arthur M. Cock died at the family home, No. 26 Court Street early this morning, after an illness of several weeks' duration.

Mr. Cock was an expert accountant and was engaged in business in New York for many years, after which he made his home in Poplar Ridge, from which place in 1886 he returned to Auburn, in which city he was born in January, 1836.

Four children, Mrs. W. J. Reed of Auburn, Charles A. Cock of Derby, Conn., Lewis H. Cock of Buffalo and Daniel F. Cock of Port Jarvis, survive, who may be assured of the sympathy of a large circle of friends in their sorrow.

Funeral services, conducted by Rev. A. [Arnold] S. Yantis, will be held at the house, Saturday morning at 2:30 o'clock.

Burial will be made beside his wife in Fort Hill Cemetery, in the family plot.
