JOHN COE DIES AT SOUTH LIVONIA
Conesus Native Succumbs After Several Weeks' Illness—Personals

John Coe died at his home in South Livonia at 5:20 Tuesday morning after an illness of over five weeks. Complications following pneumonia caused his death.

Mr. Coe was the son of George F. and Alta Stone Coe and was born in Conesus in 1853. He had spent all his life in Conesus and Livonia and had lived in what is known as the Frutchey place for the past six or eight years.

The funeral will be held this (Thursday) afternoon with a prayer at the home at 2 o'clock, and services at the Conesus community church at 2:30. The Rev. Clara Morgan [Universalist minister] of Cohocton will officiate. Interment will be in Arnold cemetery, Conesus.

Mr. Coe is survived by his wife, Blanche Morrell Coe, and one son, John, Jr., who lived at home; one sister, Mrs. Anna Webster, of Conesus; also three grandchildren.

Many will remember Mr. Coe for his service of thirty years in the county as acting sheriff, undersheriff and deputy sheriff.
