She was a woman of remarkable energy, intelligent and refined. Altho' always frail she reared a large family, her husband having died when the children were small. She was best known in her own circle of children and relatives. The children now living are Darwin and Hamilton Cole, with whom she always lived and died, one daughter, Miss Marion Cole, Byron Cole of Richfield, and Harrison Cole of Providence, R.I.
