Charles Cole, a very highly esteemed citizen, died at his home on Friday, June 21, at 4 p.m. He was not considered dangerous until a short time before his death. Mr. Cole was about sixty years of age; he was born and reared in this town. His integrity and kindness of heart won him many friends. He leaves a wife and two daughters who are married and live in this village, and an aged and very infirm mother, besides five brothers and two sisters. All were able to be at the funeral except the mother and one brother west and a sister in the southern part of the county. The latter's health would not permit her to come. The immediate family feel almost inconsolable, but they look to Him who has promised to comfort all who mourn. Rev. S. [Samuel] R. Ward [Universalist] officiated at the funeral. He was buried in the cemetery [St. Luke's] near the Episcopal church.
