MRS. ADELAIDE VROOMAN CONKLIN

Mrs. Adelaide Vrooman Conklin, aged seventy-two years, a highly esteemed resident of Richfield Springs for many years, died Monday in Thanksgiving Hospital in Cooperstown after an illness of a month's duration.

Mrs. Conklin was of Revolutionary ancestry and was born in Cherry Valley, October 21, 1853, a daughter of Nicholas and Maryetta Sternberg Vrooman. She was the eldest of a large family. She had resided in Richfield Springs since early girlhood. She was married to William Conklin, November 24, 1874. Her husband and a daughter, Mabel, preceded her in death. She was a member of the Universalist church.

She leaves a daughter, Mrs. William H. [Grace Adelaide] Doubleday, Cooperstown; two brothers, Samuel and Fred Vrooman, Richfield Springs; two sisters, Mrs. George Shoudy, Richfield Springs, and Mrs. Ward Dutton, West Winfield, also several nieces and nephews.

The funeral was held from the home in Division street, Richfield Springs, Wednesday at 2:30 p.m., the Rev. D. C. Davies officiating. Interment will be made in Lakeville cemetery.
