Mrs. Henrietta Conklin

Mrs. Henrietta Conklin, widow of Nathan B. Conklin, passed away Sunday morning at the ripe age of 84 years. Death resulted from old age. Deceased was born in the old house on the Samuel J. Brush place at West Neck, November 2, 1823, and passed her whole life in this vicinity. [On] November 23, 1847, she was married to Mr. Conklin by the Rev. James McDougall, long time a pastor of the old First church. Mrs. Conklin was the daughter of George Sammis and Ruth Conklin, and was the last of four children to depart this life. Three children survive her, Miss Lavinia H. Conklin, Evelyn, the wife of Prof. Frank Irwin, and George S. Conklin, all of this place. Mr. Conklin died December 7, 1902. Deceased was a member of the First Universalist church, of this village, and was a woman of quiet demeanor and rare Christian virtue. The funeral services were held from her late home on Carver place Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock, the Rev. R. K. Polk officiating, and the interment was in the Rural cemetery.
