MRS. JENNIE CONKLIN

Mrs. Jennie (Stowell) Conklin, aged eighty-one, widow of George Vandever Conklin, died Tuesday in the Mary Imogene Bassett hospital where she was admitted Monday night from the Pier Nursing home. Born in Middlefield November 1, 1865, she was the daughter of Orlando R. and Mary J. (Crippen) Stowell. All her life had been lived in this area. She was married October 21, 1885, to Mr. Conklin, whose death occurred December 4, 1938.

The only immediate survivor is a sister, Mrs. Carleton VanHorne of Cooperstown.

She attended the Universalist church in this village as long as services continued in the Cooperstown church.

Funeral services were held at 2 p. m. from the Tillapaugh Funeral home on Thursday. The Rev Charles Kramer, retired Universalist pastor, officiated, and burial was in Fly Creek cemetery.
