Mrs. Lucy A. Conklin of Southold became a victim of ill health in the years of comparatively young womanhood. Nevertheless, through the many years of suffering she was a great helper to her husband, the late Rev. Abram Conklin. Her death occurred on October 19, at the age of 81 years at her home in Southold. Shortly before Mr. Conklin's death last February they celebrated their golden wedding anniversary. She is survived by several nephews and nieces. The memorial service on October 22 at her late home was conducted by the Rev. R. H. Bird, Jr., pastor of the Universalist church in Southold, and the Rev. W. H. Floyd.

The Southold church receives a bequest of \$2,000 in her will, to be known as the Israel and Nancy Halsey Peck Fund for the benefit of the church. Should no services be held for five years the amount will revert to the State Convention. After the special bequests have been paid, the remainder is to be divided equally between Israel P. Terry, Mary F. Moore, the Eastern Long Island Hospital and the Universalist church.
