Connelly

Fred J. Connelly died at his home in Fishers at 6 o'clock this morning, aged 38 years. Mr. Connelly had been ill for about two weeks with an intestinal trouble and for several days little hope had been entertained for his recovery.

Mr. Connelly was long prominently identified with the business life of Fishers and had lately been employed as a buyer and lender for (?) G. Loomis & Son, produce dealers of this village. He was a genial and kind hearted man and had a large circle of friends who will deeply regret his untimely death.

Fred J. Connelly was the son of John J. and Sarah Connelly. The father, a widely known dealer in farm produce died several years ago [in 1890]. Surviving relatives are the wife [Bertha *Carpenter* Connelly], one daughter Thelma, his mother, Mrs. Sarah [*Murphy*] Connelly, and two sisters, Mrs. Charles [Ida] Snyder of this village and Mrs. George [Adeline] Fowler of Fishers.
