Obituary.

In Elmira, N.Y., October 13, 1908, Charles Coon, son of Peleg and Josephine Lord Coon, passed on to that country where there is no sorrow, sighing, crying or pain. Born Sept. 6, 1877, he was afflicted from the age of 12 years with rheumatism which as he grew older became so chronic as to confine him to his bed, where the last five years of his life were spent. Unable to help himself in any way yet he bore his heavy burden with Christian resignation and cheerfulness even. Funeral services, conducted by Rev. G. W. Raeburn, were held Friday, Oct. 16, in the Universalist church in Friendship, of which deceased was a member.
