Edward Cotton Dies

Edward Cotton, 80, died yesterday noon at his home on Main Street following a heart attack.

He was born Nov. 25, 1873, in the Town of Danube, son of Mr. and Mrs. Elmiron [Almeron] Cotton. He had been a resident of Ft. Plain 34 years. He retired in 1949 from the Arkell & Smith plant in Canajoharie where he had been employed. He attended the Universalist Church.

The survivors are one son, Harold Cotton of Ft. Plain; one half-brother, Fred Cotton of St. Johnsville, also several nieces and nephews.

Funeral services will be held Monday at 2 p.m. at the Swartz Funeral Home. The Rev. Lyman Achenbach of the Universalist Church will officiate. The body will be placed in the Catherine Nellis Memorial chapel vault for burial in the Ft. Plain Cemetery in the Spring.
