S. H. COVELL, 63, DIES ON MONDAY
Former Postmaster of Central Square Had Been in Poor Health Some Time

CENTRAL SQUARE, Sept. 17—Sherman H. Covell, 63, one time postmaster of this village, and prominent in Democratic politics, died at his home here Monday night. He had been in poor health for several years.

He was born at Munnsville, the son of John and Helen Covell. He had been a resident of Central Square for 29 years, and for some time was operator of the Franklin restaurant. He was a member of the local Universalist church. He served as postmaster for four years, retiring in 1938 because of poor health. At one time he was a member of the Democratic county committee.

Surviving are his wife, Mrs. Bessie Covell; two daughters, Mrs. Marion Knapp of North Syracuse, and Miss Katherine Covell; a son, John Covell, the latter both of Central Square, three grandchildren, and two sisters, Mrs. Neva Saucette, and Mrs. M. O. Mayzole, both of Munnsville.

Private funeral services will be held Thursday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the home, conducted by the Rev. William J. Metz, pastor of the Universalist church. Burial will be in Central Square cemetery. Friends may call at the home Tuesday and Wednesday evenings.
