18. James Moyer Cramer. The inscription on one face of the Cramer grave marker in the Fort Plain cemetery reads, "James M. Cramer born June 2, 1844, died Sept 18, 1893." An undated clipping reads: "James M. Cramer, a well known resident of Van Hornesville died Monday night, aged 45 years. He conducted the flax mill at Van Hornesville for a number of years. His wife [Jane Ann Siver Cramer] and three sisters [Lodema, Catherine and Christina] survive him. The funeral will be held from the Universalist church at Van Hornesville. Rev. E. [Edward] A. Perry will officiate and the obsequies will be in charge of the Van Hornesville lodge of Odd Fellows. The remains will be interred in the Fort Plain cemetery."
