Dolgeville DEATH OF PETER CRAMER

Last Tuesday morning Peter Cramer, an old resident, was found lying face downward on the floor in his room dead. He was around as usual the night before and about 10 P.M. showed an agent to his room, after which he soon retired. Not arising at his usual hour the following morning, his door was opened[,] when he was found. Dr. Getman was summoned and stated that death had occurred some five hours before, and pronounced the case heart failure. He deemed an inquest unnecessary. Mr. Cramer was born in the town of Oppenheim and was about 66 years of age. He for many years conducted a hotel in that place and afterwards in Dolgeville. He leaves two sons, Eugene and Addison. The latter is proprietor of the Loomer House and with him deceased lived at the time of his death. The funeral was held Thursday, Rev. V. [Vincent] E. Tomlinson [Universalist], of Little Falls, officiated.
