MRS. CRIMMINS DEAD AT 67

Funeral services for Mrs. Daniel J. Crimmins, 67, of 1446 S. Salina st., for many years prominent in social and club affairs here, who died yesterday at Syracuse Memorial Hospital, will take place at the W. A. Fancher establishment rooms Wednesday morning at 10 o'clock, Rev. Ellsworth C. Reamon [Universalist] officiating. Interment will be in Camden cemetery. A native of Boston, Mrs. Crimmins came to New York State with her parents when a child. She resided in Camden before coming here 23 years ago. For more than 20 years she was a member of the Kanatenah Club. She was also a member of the Syracuse Colony, National Society of New England Women, Central City Chapter, Order of Eastern Star; South Side Library Club and To-whan ta-qua Chapter, D.A.R. Surviving are her husband; two sons, John D. Crimmins of Syracuse and Charles H. Crimmins of Miami, Fla.; a daughter, Mrs. Orlie M. [Marie¹] Clem, whose husband is a professor at Syracuse University; a sister, Mrs. C. J. Wright of Utica; a brother, Charles Hendley of Camden; and two grandchildren.
