WIDELY KNOWN RESIDENT DIES IN HALLSVILLE
Mrs. Nettie Cronkhite Taken After Attending Church in Fort Plain
ACTIVE IN CLUBS
Member of Fort Plain D.A.R., Universalist Church and Otsquago Grange

FORT PLAIN—Mrs. Nettie Cronkhite, 59, widow of Fred Cronkhite, died suddenly at her home in the Hallsville section of this town Sunday afternoon from a heart attack. Mrs. Cronkhite had attended the morning services in the Fort Plain Universalist church and she seemed to be in her usual health.

Mrs. Cronkhite was a lifelong resident of this section. She was born August 9, 1872 in the town of Danube, Herkimer county, the daughter of James and Katherine Russ Bellinger. She was a member of the Fort Plain Chapter, D.A.R., Universalist church and Otsquago Grange of Hallsville and she took an active interest in these organizations. Mrs. Cronkhite was well known throughout this section.

She is survived by one son, Harold Cronkhite; one daughter, Mrs. Charles E. Stockwell; three grandsons; two sisters, Mrs. Byron E. Fake and Mrs. Victor S. Bauder, all of this town; one brother, George Bellinger of the town of Danube.

The funeral will be held Wednesday at 2 P.M. at her late home, and Rev. Rufus H. Dix, pastor of the Fort Plain Universalist church officiating. Interment will be made in the Mount Hope cemetery at Minden.
