OBITUARY

FREDERICK AUGUSTUS CROSS, 61 years old, of 741 Kenmore place, Flatbush, died on Saturday from apoplexy. Mr. Cross was a former resident of the Eastern District of Brooklyn, and for many years a member of All Souls Universalist Church. He was the secretary of Conzen & son Coal Company of Brooklyn and was formerly for several years connected with the coal firm of Curtis, Blaisdell & Co. Mr. Cross was born in New York City, the son of Joseph and Margaret Cross. He is survived by two sisters, Minnie L. [Cross] and Ms. Frederick Gaus, and five brothers, George F., Charles A., superintendent of the Williamsburg branch of the Brooklyn Union (?) Company; James E., of Buffalo; William and Edward Cross. The funeral services this evening will be conducted by the Rev. Dr. A. Eugene Bartlett, pastor of All Souls Church, and the interment will be in Cypress Hills Cemetery.
