Louise K. Crowell, daughter of Charles and Loretta King, and wife of Albert E. Crowell, died Monday night in her thirty-second year, after a lingering illness, at her home, 25 Marion street. She was born in Brooklyn, and attended the Universalist Church of Our Father, Grand avenue and Lefferts place. The King family is one of the oldest families of the Twenty-third Ward. Her father is a veteran of the Civil War, having served in the Twenty-eighth Regiment. The services will be held this evening at her late home at 8 o'clock, and interment will be made in Greenwood Cemetery tomorrow afternoon.
