TRUMAN CROWNER

CARTHAGE, Sept. 17.—Truman Crowner, 73, died at the Hepburn Hospital Saturday afternoon where he was operated on three weeks ago Tuesday. The operation was successful and Mr. Crowner recovered so that he was able to sit up at short intervals, but he suddenly grew worse.

Mr. Crowner was born in the town of Wilna in 1851, the son of Peter and Susan Crowner. He was united in marriage to Emma Brown 40 years ago. She survives. For 33 years he had resided on the farm where he died. Besides the widow there survive one sister, Mrs. Frank Allen of Natural Bridge, two brothers, Marion Crowner of Black River and Hubert Crowner of Wilna. An adopted son, George Austin, died five years ago [during the influenza epidemic]. The funeral will be held at the house at 1 P.M. Tuesday, Rev. G. D. [George Delbert] Walker [Universalist] of Carthage officiating. Burial will be in Pierce's Cemetery.
