Harold Crowther Dies in Albion

ALBION—A service is to be held at 3 p.m. Friday in the Merrill-Grinnell Funeral Home here for Harold Crowther, 74, of 224 East Ave., Albion, who died unexpectedly in his home Tuesday evening (March 17, 1964).

He had been a resident of Albion for more than 70 years and had been a retail coal dealer here for many years. More recently, until his retirement, he had been a custodian at the local high school building. He was a member of the Universalist Church here and had filled various offices in that church over the years. He had served at one time as a member of the Albion Board of Education.
