DEATHS.

—Henry Crowther, of the firm of Crowther & Son, coal dealers, died on Thursday at his home on East Avenue, after several months illness, aged 55 years. He was born in England and came to this country about thirty years ago, and for several years followed his trade as a stone cutter. He was one of the organizers of the Acme Coal Storage Company, of Albion, and president of that company at the time of his death. He was a member of the Pullman [Memorial Universalist] church and of the Modern Woodmen of America. He is survived by his wife [Mary Ann *Naylor* Crowther], one daughter, Mrs. Geo. P. Kurtz of Buffalo; one son, Harold Crowther of Albion. The funeral was held Friday afternoon, Rev. E. P. Wood officiating. Burial at Mt. Albion.
