Entered Into Rest.

Dr. A. G. Cruttenden died at his residence in this village on Saturday evening, June 7th, the cause of his death being a stomach and heart trouble, coupled with old age. He had been in feeble health for some months and his death was not unexpected. Dr. Cruttenden was born in Livingston, Wyoming county, a little over seventy-five years ago. For the past thirty-five years he has been a practicing physician in this village, where he had a large practice. He was foremost in all matters of reform and took a lively interest in public affairs. A good citizen has gone to rest. He leaves two daughters, Mrs. T. E. Sewell, of Aberline [Abilene] Kas., and Miss Louise Cruttenden, of this village. The funeral was largely attended at the M.E. Church on Tuesday afternoon, at 2 o'clock, the Rev. O. [Ora] M. Hilton, pastor of the Universalist church of which the deceased was a member, preaching the sermon, and Rev. Drs. McCarty and Clover assisting in the exercises. The interment took place in the Sawyer burying ground.
