GEORGE CURRY

Schuyler Lake—George W. Curry, 69, a resident here for 50 years, died yesterday in Imogene Bassett Hospital, Cooperstown, after a long illness.

He was born in Burlington Green, the son of George and Ida Clark Curry.

He married Gladys Light on Sept. 9, 1919 in East Syracuse. The couple have resided here since then.

Mr. Curry was a former station agent for the Southern New York Railway Co. until the company ceased operations. He was also employed for many years by the Shirkatch Fishing Tackle Co., Richfield Springs, until his retirement two years ago.

He was a member of the Universalist Church.

Besides his wife, he leaves a daughter, Mrs. Truman Davis, and a son, Herman, both of Schuyler Lake, and a sister, Mrs. Lee J. Chase, Mohawk.

The funeral will be at 1 Tuesday from the Chase-Persons Funeral Home, 43 E. Main St., Mohawk, and at 2:30 from the Universalist Church, Schuyler Lake, with the Rev. Harold Saxton officiating. Burial will be in the Schuyler Lake Cemetery.
