MRS. LOTTIE M. CURRY

Mrs. Lottie M. Curry died Saturday in Phoenix Mills.

Mrs. Curry was born December 20, 1874 in Westford, daughter of Jacob and Margaret (Gridley) Tipple. She was married twice, first to Emerson Stickles, on December 25, 1890. Mr. Stickles died December 9, 1915. Her second husband was Frank Curry, whom she married in 1920 and who died in 1928.
