Harry W. Damoth

An Army veteran of more than 20 years, Harry W. Damoth of Cohocton died yesterday in the Bath Veterans Administration Center at the age of 76.

Born Nov. 24, 1877, he served in the Army from June 2, 1899 to Dec. 29, 1919. His World War I service included duty as first sergeant in the 10th Field Artillery. He entered the Veterans Center Hospital Jan. 11.

Survivors include his widow, Mrs. Harriet Wagner Damoth of Cohocton; two brothers, John Damoth of Hammondsport and Roy Damoth of Corning; two sisters, Mrs. Freda Allen of Ithaca and Mrs. Bertha Tillotson of Costa Mesa, Calif.

The body is at the Shepard-VanPatton Funeral Home in Avoca. Prayer services will be conducted at 2 p.m. Saturday at the family residence on South Main St. in Cohocton and at 2:30 p.m. at the First Presbyterian Church of Cohocton with the Rev. Dr. [Donald B. F.] Hoyt, pastor of the First Universalist Church of Rochester officiating. A military funeral will follow. Burial will be in Mapleview Cemetery in Cohocton.
