Death of a Former Resident

STAFFORD, Sept. 5.—Charles Danolds, a native of this place, died at Eagle Harbor, in Orleans county, about 12 o'clock Sunday night. The deceased was born in this place on August 17, 1818. At the age of 15 years he removed with his father to Oak Orchard, where he received his education, and later became the proprietor of the hotel which he conducted [for] about ten years. In 1848 he moved to Eagle Harbor, embarking in the mercantile business. He was largely interested in the canal business, being general superintendent of the western addition of the Erie and Genesee Valley canals. He also owned and conducted four canal boats. Mr. Danolds was the oldest Mason in Orleans county. In politics he was a democrat, and in religion a Universalist. He is survived by his wife [Mary Hammond Danolds] and one son, Warren S. Danolds, of Albion, and one daughter, Mrs. Carrie P. Cole, of Eagle Harbor. The funeral will be held on Thursday at 2 o'clock from the family reidence.
