ALFRED DART

The Lansing (Mich.) Journal of Sept. 10th has the following notice of Mr. Alfred Dart, who died recently in that city. Mr. Dart was a former resident of West Potsdam and a brother of Hon. W. A. Dart of this village.

Alfred Dart, 86 years of age and a resident of Lansing since 1855, died Saturday night at 807 Walnut street north, where he had resided for the last 30 years. Although he had remained unusually active, both physically and mentally, during his bright and honored old age, his death was exceptionally painless and peaceful. He was able to attend the farmers' recent picnic at Grand Ledge, but became confined to his bed soon after that date, and his death had been hourly expected during the past week.

Mr. Dart was born in Vermont in 1802, and 63 years ago was married to Miss Jane E. Wright, who died in Lansing in 1882. The children surviving him are: E. W. Dart and Mrs. S. E. Longyear of this city, R. G. Dart of Petosky and James R. Dart of Webberville. Mr. Dart was an active Universalist for many years, and was respected and beloved throughout the city.
