—The death of Julius S. Dart occurred early Thursday morning at his home in this town. Mr. Dart had been in poor health for over a year but had not been confined to his bed. Acute indigestion was the cause of his sudden death. The deceased was born in Sherburne 67 years ago and when 6 years old moved here where he has since resided. He led a very active life, having taught school when a young man, was a mechanic and had charge of the butter factory for several years. He was a member of the Universalist church and acted as trustee for several years. He will be greatly missed in the community. [On] October 14, 1862, he married Amy Williams, who, with one daughter, Mrs. Lew Wallace, survives him. The funeral was held from his late home Saturday afternoon, Rev. C. E. Bingham officiating.
