IRVING GRANT DAVIS DIES

Redlands, Cal., December 31—Irving Grant Davis died at his home in Redlands today.

Mr. Davis was a former resident of the Eastern District of Brooklyn. His father was the late Captain Louis H. Davis of Port Jefferson and Brooklyn.
