Levi Davis, an old pioneer, aged 87 years, a good man of an excellent family, died at the residence of his son-in-law C. [Charles] Caswell, in the southern part of our town, last Sunday morning. The funeral services, conducted by Rev. W. S. Tansom, were held at the Universalist church, on Wednesday at 1 o'clock.
