*Funeral of Mrs. Davis*

The funeral of Mrs. Margaret Davis, widow of the late William Davis, who died Friday, took place from the residence of her sister, Mrs. Banker, 67 Van Anden street yesterday afternoon at 2 o'clock and was largely attended. Rev. O. [Ora] M. Hilton, pastor of the First Universalist church, officiated and paid a fitting tribute to the memory of the deceased. The interment was in North street cemetery. While the obsequies over the remains of Mrs. Davis were in progress in this city, the last sad rites over the remains of her brother, William Tuttle, were being observed at Syracuse. Mr. Tuttle also died on Friday, within a few hours of the death of his sister. The fact was touchingly referred to by Mr. Hilton in his remarks at the Davis funeral.
