George Ellis Day, born in Dansville, N.Y., over 70 years ago, died of primary latent sclerosis at his home in this village, where for years he has resided, Monday evening, Nov. 15, 1926.

Ellis, as he was known to old and young throughout the entire section, had spent most of his life in this village. He was married to Miss Mamie Blair, who with two daughters, Miss Dorothy Day of Wellsville and Mrs. Howard Mingus of this village, survives him; besides three brothers, Horton and Bert of Hornell and Charles of Westfield, Pa., also a sister, Mrs. Sam Holt of Greenwood.

For many years he had been in the insurance and hide and fur business.

He had been in failing health for a long time past, but had been confined to his home only about a couple of months.

The funeral will be held from the late home, today, Thursday, at 2:30 o'clock, and burial will be in Rural cemetery, Rev. R. S. Kellerman [Universalist] officiating.
