MISS INNETTE DAYTON

Miss Innette Dayton, an inmate [a resident] of Doolittle Home, Foxboro, Mass., died Feb. 15. She entered the home on May 27, 1937, coming from La Grange, Ill.

Miss Dayton was born May 31, 1862, at Colliers, N.Y., the daughter of Gideon and Mary Coon Dayton. She was a lifelong Universalist and devoted to the Church. She endowed a subscription to the *Leader* for someone who was interested in it but could not afford it, and last year turned over the remainder of her possessions—some airplane stock—to the Publishing House.

Funeral services were held at the home Feb. 17, Rev. William Couden of Providence, R. I., officiating. Burial was in Cooperstown, N.Y.
