MRS. JESSIE DECKER

Dolgeville—Mrs. Jessie Decker, 65, life-long resident of Dolgeville until three years ago when she moved to Mohawk, died Mar. 13, 1947 in the Whitten Nursing Home, Mohawk after being a patient there for several months.

Born in North Litchfield on June 4, 1881, she was a daughter of Henry and Elizabeth Crim Murphy. A practical nurse by profession, she attended the Universalist Church. In 1899 she was married to William Argen Decker who died on June 14, 1943.

She leaves a brother, George Murphy, Mohawk; a sister, Mrs. Alfred Busch, Salisbury Center, and several nieces and nephews.

The funeral will be held at 3 p.m. today from the Jacobson Funeral Home, the Rev. C.[Clinton] A. Moulton of the Universalist Church will officiate. The body will be placed in a local vault for burial in Inghams Mills Cemetery in the spring.
