Mrs. Eleanor Aylesworth Deming

[On] Saturday evening, the 7th inst., at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Andrew Shute's, where she had resided for the past several weeks, occurred the death of Mrs. Eleanor Aylesworth Deming, after an illness of several years' duration.

Mrs. Deming was a native of Broome County, born at Colesville, May 31, 1847, the daughter of the late Bennett R. Aylesworth and Martha (Travis) Aylesworth; united in marriage in early womanhood with the late Ceylon Deming, they resided at Morris, Toddsville and for several years at Oneonta, where occurred the death of the husband about ten years ago. For the last four years Mrs. Deming made her home at Toddsville. Two daughters were born to them: Claudia, who died in early childhood, and the late Mrs. Lena Randall, deceased about five years. Surviving relatives are a grandson and granddaughter, Harry Randall and Mrs. Eleanor Georgia, both of Oneonta; a brother, Frank Aylesworth of South Edmeston; two greatgrandsons, John Randall and Carson Georgia, also of Oneonta and two nieces and one nephew, Mrs. Fay Snyder of Toddsville and Mrs. Ezra Holdridge and Earl Aylesworth of South Edmeston.

Mrs. Deming was affiliated with the Universalist society and the Woman's Relief Corps while a resident of Oneonta. Funeral services were held at the late home Monday at 2 p.m.[,] the Rev. F. T. Hall of Cooperstown, officiating. Interment in the family plot in the Toddsville cemetery.—Toddsville Reporter.
