Mrs. Merritt Deusenbury

Jane Henry, daughter of Smith and Hannah Henry, was born in the town of Canadice, Ontario county, January 1, 1840, and died Thursday, October 5, 1899, at her home in Cohocton.

She was married to Merritt Deusenbury in 1858, and came to Cohocton in the same year to reside. She became ill in November 1898 and bore her suffering patiently until death released her.

Among those who mourn her loss are her husband, Merritt Deusenbury; three daughters, Mrs. Alice Mills of Rochester, Mrs. Charles Thorpe and Mrs. Miner Conley of this place, an adopted son, Mark Deusenbury; two sisters—Mrs. A. J. Hyland and Mrs. J. C. Green of this place and three brothers, John Henry of Palmyra, Mich., Hugh Henry of Athens, Mich., and Smith Henry of Columbus, Ohio.

The funeral was held at the Universalist church, Sunday, October 8, the service being conducted by Rev. F. S. Swan. Interment in the Maple View cemetery.
