MRS. CELIA DEVENDORF

ST. JOHNSVILLE, March 25.—Mrs. Celia A. Devendorf, 88, widow of Abram Devendorf, died Wednesday night at the home of her son, I. S. Devendorf, East Main street.

Mrs. Devendorf was born in the town of Minden, May 24, 1843, the daughter of Levi and Julia Snell. During the Civil war she was married to Abram Devendorf, later moving to Fort Plain. Following the death of her husband she made her home with her son in St. Johnsville. She was a member of the Universalist church of Fort Plain.

She leaves, besides the son mentioned, two grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

The funeral will be held Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock, with the Rev. Rufus A. Dix, pastor of the Universalist church, Fort Plain, officiating. Interment will be made in the Fort Plain cemetery.
