—Solomon S. Devendorf, of this village, suffered a stroke of paralysis while in the store of Devendorf & Rich, shortly before 3 o'clock yesterday afternoon. He became disabled while standing near a table in the rear part of the store, and was observed by Mr. Rich, who went quickly to his assistance and saved him from falling. Dr. Graves was summoned and administered the usual remedies, after which he was removed to the home of his son, A. C. Devendorf, on Court street. Owing to his advanced age, 77 years, the chances for recovery are unfavorable.
