Mrs. Mary A. Devoe, the wife of Frank M. Devoe, died at her home, [67?] Norman avenue, Thursday morning, at the age of sixty-three years. She was born in Manhattan, but had been a resident of Greenpoint since 1867. Mrs. Devoe was one of the most earnest workers in the Universalist church on North Henry street [Third Universalist], and took a very active interest in promoting the erection of the present church building. Her interest in the church continued during the entire period of her residence in Greenpoint. At the time of her death she was president of the Ladies' Aid Society of the church. Besides her husband she is survived by one son, Frank M. Devoe, jr. The funeral service will take place this evening at the Universalist Church on North Henry street, at 8 o'clock. The Rev. George L. Thompson, pastor of the church, will be assisted by other clergymen in conducting the service. The interment will be made in Cypress Hills Cemetery to-morrow morning under the direction of Oscar A. Boch.
