BENJAMIN L. DIBBLE

The funeral service for Benjamin Leslie Dibble, who died Tuesday at his home in LeRoy, is to be held Friday at 2 p.m. in McNall's funeral home, with the Rev. L. [Lewis] H. Robinson, pastor of the Pullman Memorial Universalist Church, officiating. Burial will be made at Mt. Albion Cemetery. For a long time resident at Sheldon's Corners with his wife, the former Sadie Banister, Mr. Dibble had retired from active farming in the Spring of 1931 after 32 years spent in this occupation. His age was 59. He was born Mar. 17, 1878 at Auburn, also the birthplace of both his parents, William and Emlye McRea Dibble. Since 1933 LeRoy had been his home. For 13 years Mr. Dibble had assisted his wife as a rural collector for the Democrat & Chronicle [a Rochester newspaper]. Besides Mrs. Dibble, he leaves several aunts and uncles.
