Funeral of Mrs. Dickinson

The funeral of Mrs. Amy Dickinson, widow of the late Moses Dickinson, was held at her late home Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock and was largely attended. Rev. John Evans, pastor of the Universalist church at Perry, conducted the services and two selections were sung by Mrs. E. P. Burr and Mrs. John Nelson. Interment took place in the Alexander cemetery.

Mrs. Dickinson who died last Thursday morning, was 89 years old, having been born in Bennington, Vt., April 10th, 1815. She had lived in the farm where she died nearly 72 years.
