Obituary.

—Benjamin Dimick, collector at the tollgate, Wynantskill, died Sunday after a brief illness. The deceased was at one time proprietor of a popular hotel at Snyder's Lake. He was an esteemed resident of Troy for many years. Besides his wife, he is survived by one daughter. The funeral occurred from the late home in Wynantskill this afternoon. Rev. H. Bernard Smith of the Universalist Church of this city officiated and a delegation from King Solomon's Primitive Lodge, of which the deceased was a member, attended. The remains were cremated in Oakwood, where Masonic services were performed by the lodge.
