The Late Dwight M. Dominick

The late Dwight M. Dominick was born in Grieg, July 11, 1848, the son of the late John F. and Mary E. Gallup Dominick. [On] October 13, 1873, he was united in marriage with Harriet E. Carter, of Grieg. Of this union one child was born, J. Earl Dominick. He leaves to mourn his death his wife, son and granddaughter, of Albert Lea, Minn., and a brother and sister, Mrs. F. W. Case, and William J. Dominick of Grieg, to whom are extended the sympathy of their many friends. From the Albert Lea paper: "Mr. Dominick and family moved to Albert Lea from New York State about 32 years ago. He was a contractor, and has been successful in the cement business ever since. Many sidewalks and business block foundations in Broadway and elsewhere about the city, which he has built, will remain as monuments to his memory. Although he never held public office, he was interested in public affairs and, because of his firm stand, became a power for good in the city. He was most generous and charitable man, and was held in high esteem by all who knew him. He was baptized in the Universalist church, and was a member of the Workmen Lodge, which order assisted in the ceremonies at his funeral."
